

NONNA Frequently Asked Questions

1. To which Vertical Datum are NONNA products referenced?

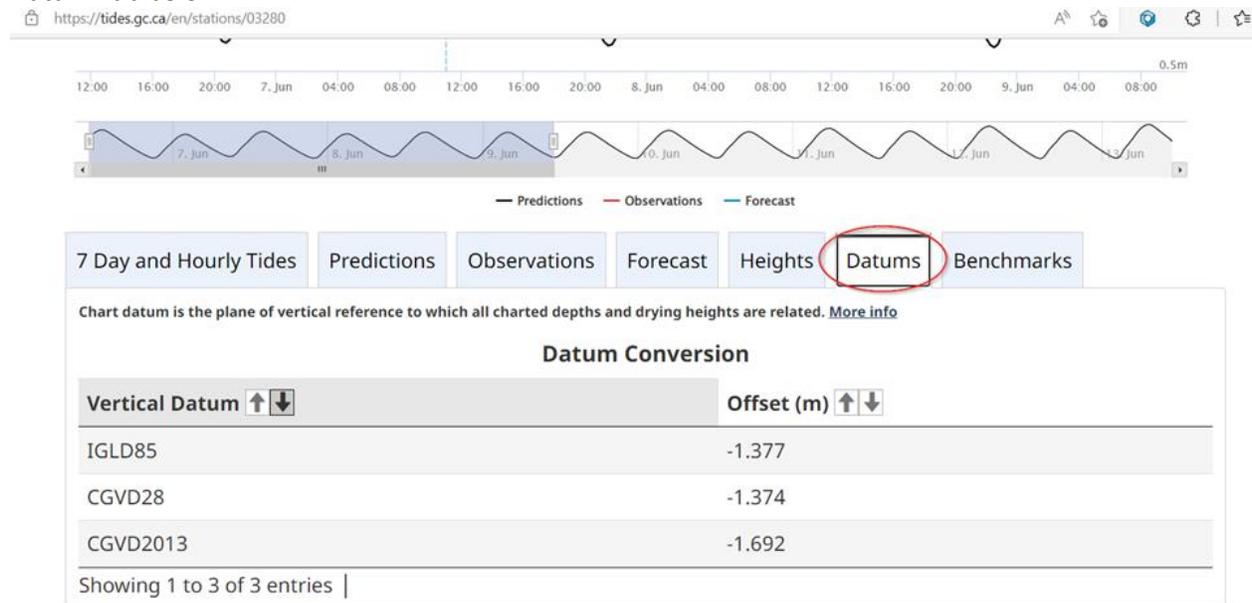
All NONNA data sources are referred to Chart Datum (CD) which is the plane of vertical reference to which all charted depths and drying heights are related.

The link below specifically deals with datums as released on Chart Products, however this can be a good reference when learning about Chart Datum in general on Canada's Tidal and In-land waters.

2. How can I vertically shift data from CD to other vertical references?

Local shift values can be found on CHS Tides and Water Levels Website [Stations \(tides.gc.ca\)](https://tides.gc.ca). See Datum Tab below.



NOTE: *The information contained in this product is established under the Chart Datum. The CHS does not establish and maintain other vertical datums such as CGVD28, CGVD2013, IGLD (1955) and IGLD (1985). References to these datums represent the best available information, to be used with caution and sound judgment where required, but it is not intended to be used for navigation.*

Hydrographic Vertical Separation Surface (HyVSEPs) allowing shifting NONNA data over other vertical references (such as NAD83SCRS2010, CGVD28, CGVD2013, IGLD85) may exist. Please contact 'chsinfo@dfo-mpo.gc.ca' to ask for any existing HyVSEPs. CHS is working on solutions to have HyVSEPs products available in the future through our web services.

3. Why are there voids in the NONNA data where there was data previously?

Due to the large volume of questions received regarding the data's datum, the CHS has prioritized the use of Chart Datum (CD) datum. Data that does not have this datum was removed and will be added as the data is updated to CD. Additionally, there are some data sources that were previously available that are now undergoing further work. These data sources will not be available until such work is complete in the CHS' Bathymetric Database.

4. What is the projection for the NONNA data?

The NONNA data is unprojected, but uses the WGS84 horizontal reference system. Longitudes and Latitudes from the NONNA data set can be further projected to your preference.

All Data formats can be loaded using the EPSG:4326, WGS84 Geographic Coordinate Reference System.

5. What is the XYZ format description?

The XYZ is a .txt file containing:

X = Latitude

Y = Longitude

Z = Depth (positive down in Metres)

6. Where can I find which sources contributed to the NONNA layer? (metadata, dates, technique of data collection etc.)

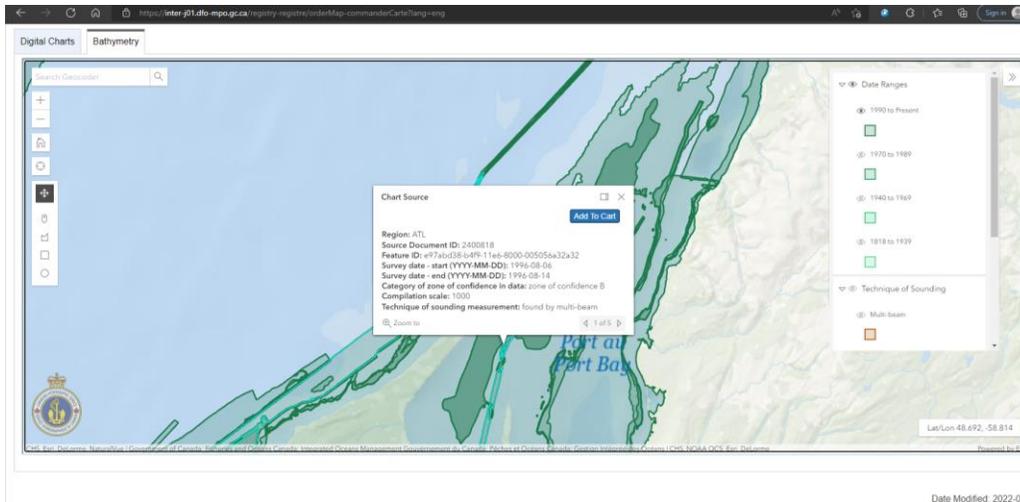

7. How Can I use the “Open Government Portal” Link: [Open Government | Open Government, Government of Canada](#) to view the NONNA data available?

1. Search for NONNA;
2. A new page will open with the **Canadian Hydrographic Service Non-Navigational (NONNA) Bathymetric Data** listed;
3. Click on **View on Map**;
4. Zoom into area to see datasets; here data is not selectable or downloadable you must go to <https://data.chs-shc.ca/login> to download data

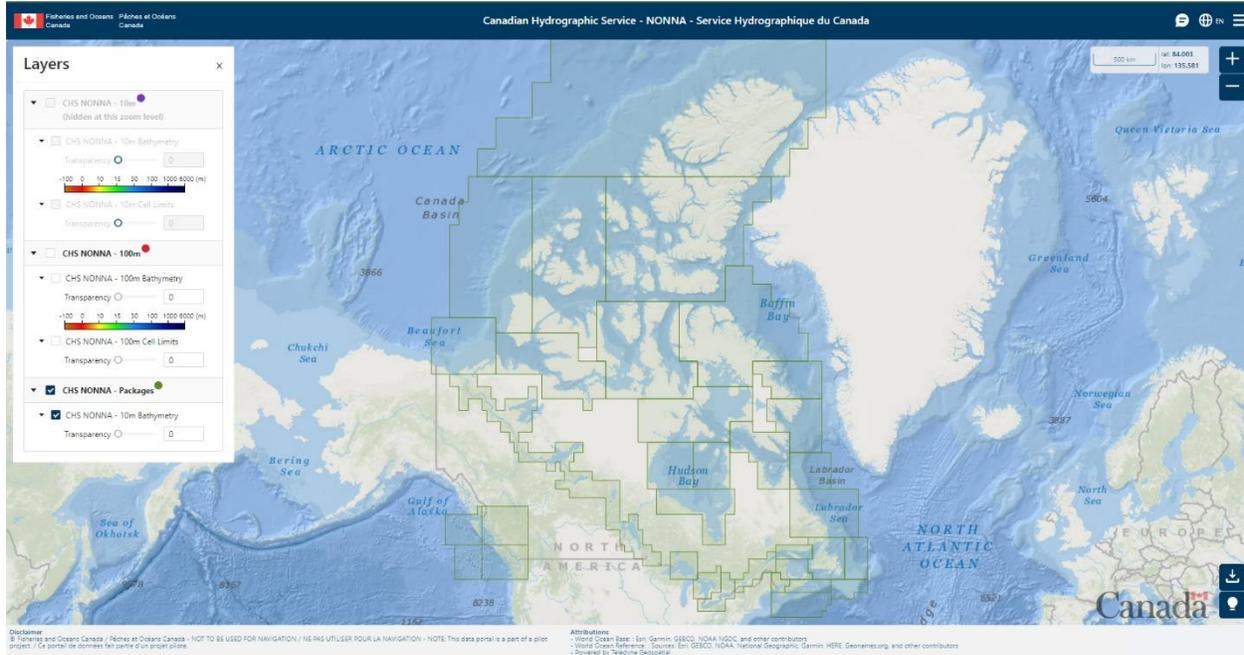

9. How do I access NONNA Packages?

NONNA Packages are the newest product available from the CHS. They were created as a way to ease the download of datasets across a large area. Packages can be downloaded from the CHS NONNA Portal website by:

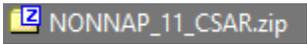
1. Enable the CHS NONNA - Packages checkmark in the Layers window - this will make the Package Cells visible on your screen;



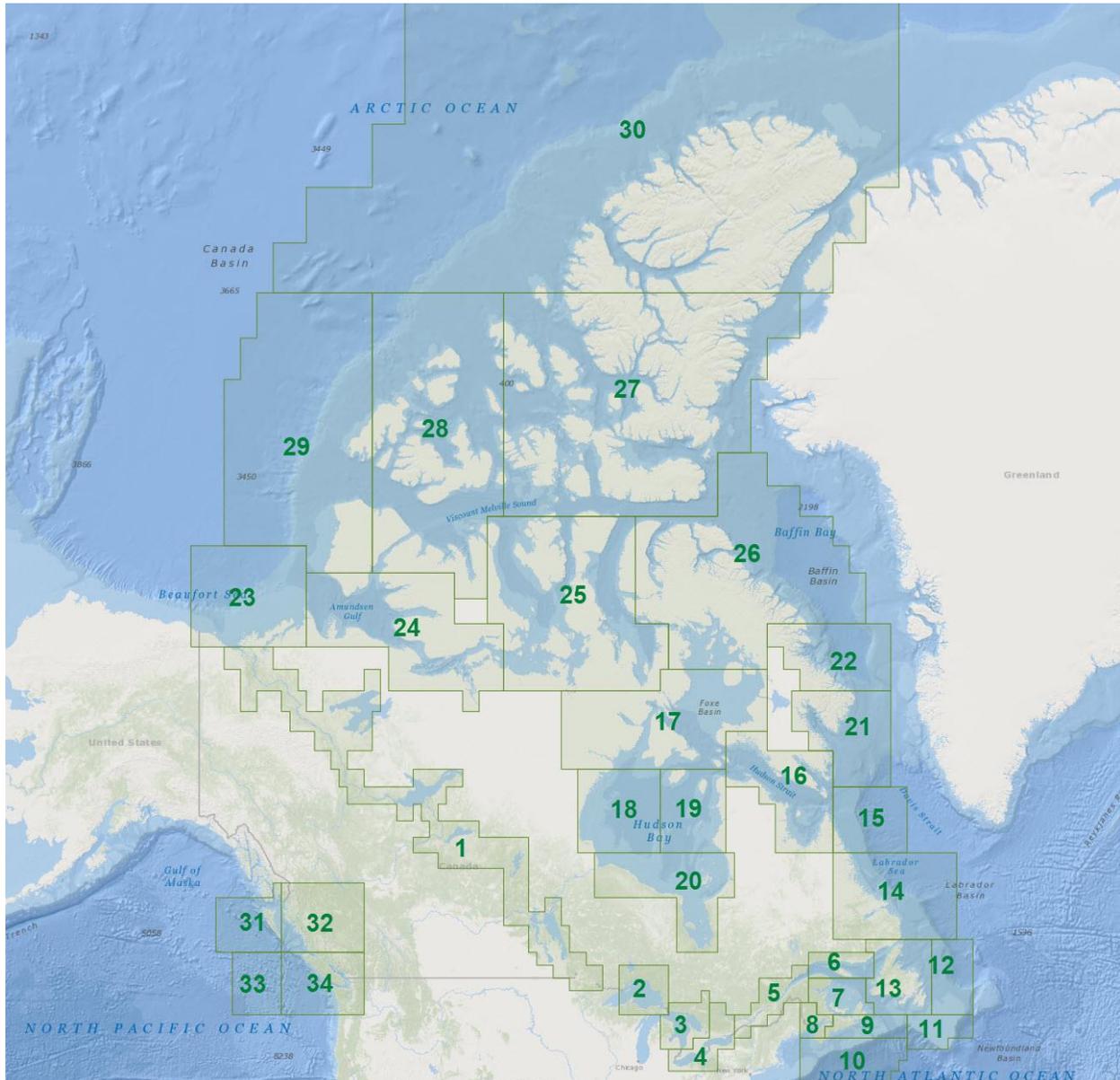
2. Select the Packages you wish to download by left clicking with your mouse and holding "ctrl";
3. Once selected proceed to download  and choose download options

10. How do I know which NONNA Packages I have downloaded?

In the downloaded ZIP file name, NONNA packages are numbered.
